☐ Official Transcripts

Provide official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended. (We can initially process your application with unofficial transcripts).

Only units from accredited institutions will be accepted for transfer.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSCRIPTS

Applicants with transcript from international institutions must have foreign transcripts evaluated by an accredited agency. (www.naces.org)

MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS

Palo Alto University will accept transfer credit awarded for courses taken in the armed services In order to have your military educational experiences evaluated for credit, you must submit evaluated transcript(s) from the appropriate agency below:

Transcript Definitions

Unofficial Transcript – Any transcript that has been in the hands of the student, such as a student copy/unofficial transcript. Unofficial transcript would also be an incomplete transcript, meaning that you are still taking classes and all of your grades have not been recorded. Unofficial transcripts cannot be used to transfer to another college or university; however, we can use them to determine eligibility for acceptance.

Official/Final Transcripts - An official transcript is the University's certified statement of your <u>complete</u> academic record. The official transcript is printed on security sensitive paper, comes in a sealed envelope and contains the University seal and signature of the University Registrar.
